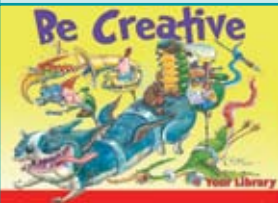

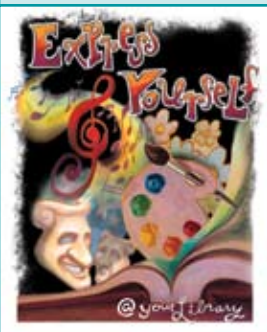
IT'S SUMMER! TIME TO READ!
