POSITION SUMMARY:

Plan and facilitate 1-2 monthly reading and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math) programs for children (grades K-4). Programs may include Early Reader Book Club, First Chapter Book Chats, and/or other STEAM-focused activities. Work as part of a team with other library staff members, demonstrate flexibility and a positive attitude, and contribute to the overall successful operation of the library.

HOURS: Hourly, part-time (4-8 hours/week). Programs run September-May, between the hours of 3-6 PM, with the possibility of continuing some programs through the summer. Non-exempt for purposes of Fair Labor Standards Act.

WAGE: \$20.50/hour.

SUPERVISED BY: Children's Librarian, Assistant/Executive Library Directors

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Specialized:

- Plan and facilitate 1-2 monthly after school programs for children (grades K-4), which may include Early Reader Book Club and/or First Chapter Book Chats.
- Work closely with Children's Librarian to ensure engaging, developmentally appropriate content is incorporated into programs.
- Develop and submit supply requests to the Children's Librarian in a timely fashion.
- Maintain attendance records for each program.

- Knowledge of children's literature
- Knowledge of age-appropriate educational benchmarks
- Computer literacy; must be competent in usage of laptop computer and presentation software such as Microsoft PowerPoint.
- Ability to run and troubleshoot audiovisual equipment for program usage.
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Ability to create a welcoming environment for the public and staff.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Required:

• BA/BS from an accredited institution, preferably in elementary education, or commensurate combination of education and experience

• Experience working directly with children and families

Required Licenses or Certification: Successful completion of pre-employment screening tests including Drug and Alcohol, Physical Examination and Criminal Background Check.
